Featuring beautiful period churches and a banquet hall perfect for a reception for up to 110 people, having your wedding at Westfield Heritage Village will ensure that you remember it for a lifetime. Ceremonies may be held in one of two 19th century churches or outside at the Victorian gazebo with receptions in the renovated Ironwood Hall. The village setting offers excellent opportunities for unique outdoor photographs.

Westfield has over 30 historic buildings including a covered 'kissing' Bridge, Log Buildings, Victorian Bandstand, Railway Station, Locomotive 103, and General Store. These buildings are relocated from various sites around southern Ontario, creating a charming village with a nostalgic atmosphere. Westfield is surrounded by an additional 131 hectares of unspoiled natural woodlands and meadows with several nature trails.

The Westfield Package includes rental of the Victorian Chapel or Bandstand, a rehearsal time, use of the Ironwood Hall which features a large kitchen, an outdoor deck, air conditioning and is wheelchair accessible. Westfield can also connect you with caterers, horse and carriage providers, old-fashioned entertainers, and photographers.
